MINUTES OF THE
DECEMBER 19, 1989 MEETING
OF THE DUPONT CIRCLE ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION
(ANC 2B)

A regularly scheduled meeting of the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC 2B) was held on Wednesday, December 19, 1989, at 7:30 p.m. at St. Thomas Church. Commissioners Dennis Bass, Jack Evans, Edward Grandis, David Maggi, Doreen Moses, and Alaire Reiffel and Staff Coordinator Nancy Melville were present. Commissioner Dennis Gaugler was absent.

Mr. Grandis moved, and Mr. Bass seconded, a motion to approve the minutes for the November 29, 1989, meeting, modified to include two conditions for approval of a special exception requested by the Lauren Condominiums. The motion was passed 3-0-2, with Mr. Maggi and Ms. Moses abstaining and Ms. Rieffel not present for the vote.

Ms. Moses moved, and Mr. Maggi seconded, a motion to enter into an agreement with the Omni Georgetown Hotel whereby the hotel agreed to restrict noise. The motion passed 5-0; Ms. Rieffel was not present for the vote.

Mr. Grandis moved, and Mr. Bass seconded, a motion to remind Domino's Pizza and Metro Supermarket that it is illegal to distribute flyers on windshields and on doors. The motion passed 4-0-1, with Mr. Maggi voting against and Ms. Rieffel not present for the vote.

Mr. Bass moved, and Mr. Maggi seconded, a motion to support Bill 8-156, D.C. Right to Overnight Shelter of 1984 Amendment Act to Establish a Comprehensive Homelessness Assistance Program for 1989. The motion passed 5-0-0, with Mr. Grandis not present for the vote.

Mr. Grandis moved, and Mr. Maggi seconded, a motion to send to the National Capital Planning Commission staff a package of the ANC's prior positions on the Planned Unit Development at 22nd and P Sts., N.W., and that David Maggi or another Commissioner be authorized to make a presentation to the NCPC on behalf of the ANC. The motion was passed unanimously.

The meeting was then adjourned.
