

MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, AUGUST 10, 1988

Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting at 7:30 p.m., August 10, 1988 at St. Thomas' Parrish, 1772 Church Street, N.W. Commissioners present were Bass, Grandis, Maggi, Maxwell, Rieffel, Schwager, and Schwartz.

1. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Grandis, to approve the minutes as submitted of ANC 2B's meeting on July 13, 1988. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 abstention (Comm. Schwartz) (Comm. Maxwell was not present for the vote).
2. Motion by Comm. Bass, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to petition the ABC Board for a moratorium on the issuance of further Retailer's Licenses Class A, B, C, or D within a 1,200 foot radius of 17th and Q Streets, N.W. Motion adopted unanimously.
3. Motion by Comm. Maxwell, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to support ABC Application No. 27773 for a new Retailer's License Class C/R of The Bombay Club, 815 Connecticut Avenue, N.W. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 no (Comm. Bass), 1 abstention (Comm. Reiffel).
4. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Maggi, to oppose changes in existing zoning regulations for the vesting of construction and occupancy rights, except for changes that would impose further restrictions on such vesting rights. Motion adopted unanimously.
5. Motion by Comm. Maxwell, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to send a letter to the Historic Preservation Review Board urging rejection of the application of the Dupont Italian Kitchen (17th and R Streets, N.W.) to construct a permanent awning over the outdoor seating area on public space because 1) the awning is inconsistent with the 17th Street design plan, 2) construction was started on the awning prior to approval of the application, and 3) the application contradicts the assertions of the Dupont Italian Kitchen (when seeking approval of ANC 2B for the public space permit) that the outdoor seating area would be covered by umbrellas, not a cover of any other kind. Motion adopted unanimously.
6. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to inform the D.C. building permit office of the Dupont Italian Kitchen's violation of the historic preservation review law, and to request that the Dupont Kitchen be required to remove the awning frame already illegally installed. Motion adopted unanimously.
7. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to adopt the six procedures as presented by Comm. Maggi for

referral to and use of the Neighborhood Mediation Service.  
Motion adopted unanimously.

8. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to adopt the treasurer's second quarter report as presented by the treasurer, Comm. Maxwell, which shows an end quarter balance of \$6,673.70. Motion adopted unanimously.

The Commission adjourned at 9:20 p.m.
