

MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, DECEMBER 14, 1988

Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting at 7:35 p.m., December 14, 1988 at St. Thomas' Parrish, 1772 Church Street, N.W. Commissioners present were Bass, Grandis, Maggi, Rieffel, Schwager, and Schwartz. Comm. Maxwell was absent.

1. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to approve the minutes as submitted of ANC 2B's meeting on November 16, 1988. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.
2. Motion by Comm. Maggi, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to support BZA Application No. 14890 of Robert I. Kling for a special exception for permission to continue a six-space accessory parking lot in an R-5-B District at the rear of 1324 22nd Street, N.W. (Square 49, Lot 35), provided that the BZA review the application after two years to insure that measures taken by the lot owners to meet the concerns of neighboring residents have resolved those problems. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.
3. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Maggi, to oppose ABC Application No. 28136 for a new Retail Class "CR" license for Rosewood Regency Co., Inc., t/a Cafe Aja, 1635 P Street, N.W. on the grounds that it is inconsistent 1) with ANC 2B's moratorium petition pending before the ABC Board, and 2) with ANC 2B's objective to maintain the residential character of the neighborhood. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 abstention (Comm. Schwartz).
4. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Maggi, to support ABC Application No. 28155 for a new Retail Class "CR" license for Capital Restaurant Alliance, Inc., t/a Pan Asian Noodles and Grill, 2020 P Street, N.W. Motion adopted, 4 yeas, 2 noes (Comms. Bass and Rieffel).
5. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to notify the Mayor that, in addition to supporting ANC 2B Commissioner Renee Schwager for appointment to a vacancy on the Zoning Commission, ANC 2B also supports the appointment of Cornish Hitchcock, who has been nominated to the post by the Citizens' Advisory Committee. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.
6. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Maggi, to ask that Council Member John Wilson duly recognize the work and contributions of outgoing ANC 2B Commissioners David Maxwell, Lex Rieffel, Renee Schwager, and Bella Schwartz. Motion adopted, 3 yeas, 1 no (Comm. Rieffel), 2 abstentions (Comms. Schwager and Schwartz).
7. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to send a letter of support and appreciation for the legal action taken by the D.C. Council against Congress to protect the First

Amendment and constitutional rights of Council Members who represent the citizens of the District of Columbia, and to congratulate the Council on a successful court decision which will strengthen home rule for the District. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 no (Comm. Maggi).

8. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Maggi, to acknowledge receipt of the Urban Institute's report: "Rent Control and the Availability of Affordable Housing the D.C." Motion adopted, 6 yeas.

9. Motion by Comm. Maggi, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to urge the U.S. Attorney to prosecute all cases where victims and witnesses are willing to participate in prosecution of the case in order to slow the increase in crime and to encourage cooperation of victims and witnesses in other crimes. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.

The Commission adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
