MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, FEBRUARY 10, 1988

Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting on February 20, 1988, at St. Thomas' Church at 7:30 p.m. Commissioners present were Grandis, Maxwell, Maggi, Rieffel, Schwager and Schwartz.

1. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to approve the minutes of ANC 2B's meeting on January 27, 1988, as amended at items 4 and 6. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Motion by Comm. Schwager, seconded by Comm. Grandis, to recommend approval of Alcoholic Beverage Control Application No. 27148 for a Class "B" License for Lawson's Gourmet Provisions, 1350 Connecticut Avenue, N.W. Motion adopted, 5 yeas and 1 abstention (Comm. Reiffel).
3. Motion by Comm. Schwager, seconded by Comm. Maxwell, to recommend the approval of BZA Application No. 14761 of the Brookings Institution for a special exception to continue to operate an accessory parking lot in an R-5-D District at 1738-48 P Street, N.W. and ask that they continue to maintain the lights and cleaning the lot. Motion adopted unanimously.
4. Motion by Comm. Maggi, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to recommend the approval of BZA Application No. 14748 of Square 35 Residential Joint Venture for a special exception to continue use of accessory parking spaces that are not located within 200 feet of the area to which they are accessory, and a variance to allow continuation of the use of accessory parking spaces that are not contiguous to or separated only by an alley from the use to which they are accessory in an R-5-B District at premises 2301 N Street, N.W., noting that ANC 2B took into account the large number of cars which would be displaced otherwise. Motion adopted, 5 yeas and 1 nay (Comm. Schwartz).
5. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Grandis, that the ANC approve the recommendation of the staff of the Historic Preservation Office for H.P.A. Nos. 88-270, 88-283, and 88-284, *concerning* the various signs and awnings at 2016 P Street, N.W. Motion adopted unanimously.
6. Motion by Comm. Maxwell, seconded by Comm. Grandis, that the ANC strongly oppose Historic Preservation Application No. 88-274 for an alteration at 1631 R Street, N.W., because we oppose affecting the berm in any manner. Motion adopted, 4 yeas, 1 nay (Comm. Rieffel), and 1 abstention (Comm. Schwartz).
7. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Maggi, that the ANC recommend that the Historic Preservation Review Board reconsider its approval of the Four Ways conceptual design on the basis of the information presented in the National Capital Planning Commission meeting of February 14, 1988. Motion adopted unanimously. *+ ask for a meeting with HP staff.*

8. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Schwager, that the ANC support the efforts of Councilmember John Wilson to decrease the total amount of the Mayor's proposed budget by insisting on greater efficiency in the management of essential services for the residents of the District of Columbia and less use of flamboyant spectacles and gimmicks. Motion adopted, 5 yeas and 1 abstention (Comm. Maggi).

9. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, that a letter be sent to Councilmember Jarvis to remind her of our statement that we had a commitment from her office that Bill 7-264 would not be marked-up until the concerns of our letter of October 27, 1987, and of Councilmember John Wilson were addressed. Motion adopted, 5 yeas and 1 abstention (Comm. Maggi).

10. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, that the ANC ask the Zoning Commission that since its notice of a public hearing on Case No. 87-31, published in the D.C. Register on December 25, 1987, did not articulate the entire scope of the issue, we respectfully request that the record be kept open for 30 days after the hearing so that written comments can be submitted. Motion adopted, 5 yeas and 1 nay (Comm. Maggi).

11. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Grandis, that the Quarterly ^{Financial} Report be approved. Motion adopted unanimously.

The Commission adjourned at 9:25 p.m.
