

MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, FEBRUARY 20, 1988

Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting on February 20, 1988, at St. Thomas' Church at 7:30 p.m. Commissioners present were Edward Grandis, David Maxwell, David Maggi, Lex Rieffel, Renee Schwager and Bella Schwartz.

1. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to approve the minutes of ANC 2B meeting on February 20, 1988, as amended at items 4 and 6. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Motion by Comm. Schwager, seconded by Comm. Grandis, to recommend approval of Alcoholic Beverage Control Application No. 27148 for a Class B license for Lawsons' Gourmet Provisions, 1350 Connecticut Avenue, N.W. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 abstention (Comm. Rieffel).
3. Motion by Comm. Schwager, seconded by Comm. Maxwell, to recommend the ANC approve BZA Application No. 14761 for a parking lot at Brookings and ask that they continue to the the lights and aid cleaning up the lot. Motion adopted unanimously.
4. Motion by Comm. Maggi, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to recommend approval of BZA Application No. 14748 for continued use of a parking lot at 2301 N Street, taking into account the large number of cars which would be displaced. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 no (Comm. Schwartz).
5. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Grandis, that the ANC approve the recommendation fo the staff of the Historic Preservation Review Board for the various signs and awning at 2016 P Street. Motion adopted unanimously.
6. Motion by Comm. Maxwell, seconded by Comm. Grandis, that the ANC strongly oppose the application before the Historic Preservation Review Board concerning 1631 R Street because we oppose affecting the berme in any manner. Motion adopted, 4 yeas, 1 no (Comm. Rieffel), 1 abstention (Comm. Schwartz).
7. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Maggi, that the ANC recommend that the Historic Preservation Review Board reconsider its approval of the Four Ways conceptual design on the basis of the information presented in the National Capital Planning Commission meeting of February 4, 1988. Motion adopted unanimously.

8. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Schwager, that the ANC support the efforts of Councilmember John Wilson to decrease the total amount of the Mayor's proposed budget by insisting on greater efficiency in the management of essential services for the residents of the District of Columbia and less use of flamboyant spectacles and gimmicks. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 abstention (Comm. Maggi).

9. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, that the ANC write a letter to Councilmember Jarvis to remind her of our statement that we had a commitment from her office that the bill on  
would not go to mark-up until the concerns raised in our letter were addressed. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 abstention (Comm. Maggi).

10. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, that the ANC ask the Zoning Commission in light of the filing of its notice dated                    not articulating the scope of the scheduled hearing that we respectfully request that the record be kept open for 30 days after the hearing. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 no (Comm. Maggi).

11. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Grandis, that the ANC approve the Treasurer's Quarterly Report. Motion adopted unanimously.
