

MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, JANUARY 27, 1988

Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting on January 27, 1988, at St. Thomas' Church at 7:35 p.m. Commissioners present were Grandis, Maggi, Rieffel, Schwager, and Schwartz.

1. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Grandis, to approve the minutes of ANC 2B's meeting on January 13, 1988. Motion adopted unanimously.
2. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to recommend approval of Alcoholic Beverage Control Application No. 9888 for a Class "C" License for Cavanaugh's Restaurant, 1823 L Street, N.W. Motion adopted, 4 years, 1 abstention (Comm. Rieffel).
3. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to add Comm. Rieffel to the ad hoc committee on the 17th Street Plan. Motion adopted unanimously.
4. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to postpone consideration of grant applications from New Playwrights' Theater and The Columbia Players to the next scheduled meeting due to a lack of grant funds. Motion adopted unanimously.
5. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to grant \$500 to the Foundry Housing Corporation for the purposes set forth in its grant application dated December 20, 1987. Motion adopted 4 years and 1 nay (Comm. Rieffel).
6. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Grandis, that ANC 2B register its opposition before the National Capital Planning Commission of the Zoning Commission's decision on Case No. 86-19, Fourways, Inc., and any rezoning because it is part of the original historic district, an individually designated Historic Landmark, and on the National Register of Historic Places; and that ANC 2B opposes any additional building on Lot 60 in Square 110 in order to maintain the integrity of the Fraser Mansion to conform to NCPC guidelines for open spaces and lower density. Motion adopted, 4 years, 1 abstention (Comm. Maggi). Comm. Maggi did not participate in consideration of this matter.

The Commission adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
