

MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, JUNE 8, 1988

Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting on June 8, 1988 at St. Thomas' Church at 7:35 p.m. Commissioners present were Bass, Grandis, Rieffel, and Schwartz. Comms. Maggi, Maxwell, and Schwager were absent.

1. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to approve the minutes as submitted of ANC 2B's meeting on May 25, 1988. Motion adopted, 4 yeas.
2. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Bass, to support ABC Application 11244 for a new Class "C/R" Liquor License for I. Ricci, Inc., t/a i Ricci, 1220 19th Street, N.W. Motion adopted, 4 yeas.
3. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Grandis, to express to the D.C. Dept. of Human Services the concern of ANC 2B over the proposal to house homeless persons in mobile homes. Motion adopted, 4 yeas.
4. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Grandis, to oppose the application in Zoning Commission Case No. 88-6C, a Consolidated Planning Unit Development at 1111 20th Street, N.W. (Vanguard Building) because 1) the benefits to the community of the amenities proposed in the application are not commensurate with the disadvantages of the two extra floors in excess of zoning requirements that are to be granted to the developer, 2) the building could and should be renovated in a manner that does not require the addition of two extra floors, and 3) this application proposes changes that are inappropriate for and inconsistent with the P.U.D. process and that undermine the integrity of the zoning regulations (which provide adequate procedures for obtaining zoning variances). Motion adopted, 3 yeas, 1 abstention (Comm. Schwartz).
5. Motion by Comm. Bass, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to urge the Mayor to act immediately to appoint a new commander for the Third Police District. Motion adopted, 4 yeas.

The Commission adjourned at 9:35 p.m.
