

MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, MARCH 9, 1988

Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting on March 9, 1988 at St. Thomas' Church at 7:30 p.m. Commissioners present were Bass, Grandis, Maggi, Maxwell, Rieffel, Schwager and Schwartz.

1. Motion by Comm. Schwager, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to approve the minutes of ANC 2B's meeting on February 24, 1988. Motion adopted, 6 yeas, one abstention (Comm Schwartz).
2. Motion by Comm. Schwager, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to support the application of the Urban Land Institute before the HPRB (HPA Case No. 88-369) for alterations (restoration, renovation, and basement addition) to the Slater Mansion, 1319 18th St., N.W. (Sq. 158, Lot 812). Motion adopted unanimously.
3. Motion by Comm. Bass, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to oppose any increase in individual income taxes in fiscal year 1989, and to support the lowering of property tax rates for residential property this year by an amount equal to that generated by the increase in residential property tax assessments in the current year. Motion unanimously adopted.
4. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to oppose Bills 7410 ("Street and Alley Closings Value Application Act of 1988") and Bill 7411 ("Street and Alley Closings and Acquisition Procedures of 1982 Amendment Act of 1988") as improper vehicles to address the problems of either alley closings or inadequate housing. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 no (Comm. Maggi), 1 abstention (Comm. Rieffel).
5. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Bass, to adopt testimony as presented by Comm. Grandis on Bill 7-264, "Housing Production Trust Fund and Linked Development Policy Act of 1988." Motion unanimously adopted.
6. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Maxwell, to support the recommendations of the Citizens Planning Coalition and the Committee of 100 in Zoning Case 87-31 on transient accommodations, with respect to definitions, and to urge the addition of a definition of "dormitory" to preclude conversion of residential facilities in R-districts to dormitory use when such facilities are not related in any way to any particular school or learning institution, and to be compatible with other D.C. government regulations as to room size and number of occupants. Motion adopted, 6 yeas, 1 no (Comm. Maggi).
7. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to support the students and faculty of Gallaudet University and members of Congress who are supporting selection of a hearing-

impaired president of Gallaudet. Motion defeated, 3 yeas (Comms. Bass, Grandis, Schwager), 4 noes.

8. Motion by Comm. Maggi, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to oppose the retail sale of cigarette papers, except in tobacco stores, within ANC 2B, and to notify retailers within ANC 2B selling such papers of the ANC's position. Motion defeated, 2 yeas (Comms. Maggi and Rieffel), 4 noes, 1 abstention (Comm. Bass).

9. Motion by Comm. Bass, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to support the recommendation of the Metropolitan Committee on AIDS Issues to add \$2.5 million to the fiscal year 1989 D.C. budget for AIDS education, testing, and treatment. Motion adopted unanimously.

10. The treasurer, Comm. Maxwell, reported that there is \$12,344.97 in ANC 2B's accounts of record as of February 29, 1988.

The Commission adjourned at 9:27 p.m.
