

SPECIAL MEETING OF ANC 2B ON NOVEMBER 14, 1988

A special meeting of ANC 2B was called by Commissioners Grandis, Schwartz, and Maxwell to consider two Historic Preservation Applications that will be considered on the morning of November 16, 1988, before the next meeting of the ANC.

The special meeting was called to order by Comm. Grandis, Vice Chair, at the Cafe Rondo, on November 14, 1988, at 6:10 p.m. Commissioners present were Grandis, Schwartz, Maxwell, Maggi, and Rieffel.

Comm. Grandis and Vernon W. Palmer II, Staff Coordinator, reported on their inspection of the conceptual designs of Application No. 89-88, 1619 R Street, N.W., and Application No. 89-84, 2014 Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., at the meeting of the Dupont Circle Conservancy on November 8, 1988.

Comm. Maxwell made the following motion regarding H.P.A. NO. 89-88: ANC 2B recommends that the Historic Preservation Review Board approve that portion of the conceptual design regarding the parking lot with a curb cut and wall adjacent to the alley on the east; ANC 2B is at odds with the architect's proposal as to the balconies in the rear (repair only those that can easily be repaired) and recommends that all balconies be restored to give a rhythmic, balanced rear facade. Comm. Schwartz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously (5-0-0).

Comm. Schwartz made the following motion regarding H.P.A. 89-84: ANC 2B recommends that the Historic Preservation Review Board approve relocating the entrance to the center of the building and oppose all other aspects of the application, in particular the glass canopies over windows and on the roof as they are not compatible with the architectural character of the neighborhood. Comm. Maggi seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously (5-0-0).

The special meeting was adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
