MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, OCTOBER 12, 1988

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting on October 12, 1988 at St. Thomas Church at 7:30 p.m. Commissioners present were Edward S. Grandis, David Allan Maggi, Alexis Rieffel, Renee A. Schwager and Bella Schwartz.

1. Motion by Comm. Maggi that ANC 2B recommend to the U.S. Park Service that the Federal parklands located west of 21st St., NW and bordered by Rock Creek Park on the west, commonly known as the P Street Beach and Black Forest area, be closed from dusk to dawn as an effort to address crime problems in the area. Motion passed unanimously.

2. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Maggi, that ANC 2B inform the BZA that it is opposed to Application No. 14913 of 1520 New Hampshire Associates on behalf of the Financial Office of the Embassy of Spain for permission to locate a chancery on the first floor on the grounds that the Embassy should look for space within an area already designated for diplomatic use. Motion adopted 4 yeas, 1 no (Comm. Schwartz).

3. Motion by Comm. Schwartz that ANC 2B opposes Historic Preservation Application No. 88-1053 because the proposal for a sidewalk flower stand on the west side of Connecticut Avenue is not conducive to the area, there is no vending on the west side of Connecticut Avenue north of N Street, it would be in a busy pedestrian area, it would set a bad precedent and it is not consistent with the historical nature of the neighborhood. The motion was adopted unanimously.

4. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, that ANC 2B restate our firm position in opposition to Bill 7-714 as submitted, that the ANC does not support the concept of linkage in that the concept is the problem, not the words of the bill, that the ANC opposes selling the right to ignore zoning restrictions and that the ANC suggests that he work on an economically and socially sound alternative. Motion adopted unanimously.

5. Grant application by Foundry Housing Corporation. The grant applicant made a presentation for a grant for \$500. Under the ANC's grant procedures, the matter will be considered at the next public meeting of the ANC. The applicant was commended for the completeness of their application package.

6. Candidates for seats on the ANC made presentations. For SMD 1 -- Edward S. Grandis; for SMD 2 -- Kyle Pitsor and Doreen Moses; for SMD 3-- Alaire Bretz Rieffel; for SMD 6 -- David Allan Maggi; and for SMD 7 --JACK Evans.
