

MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, SEPTEMBER 14, 1988

Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting at 7:30 p.m., September 14, 1988 at St. Thomas' Parrish, 1772 Church Street, N.W. Commissioners present were Bass, Grandis, Maggi, Rieffel, Schwager, and Schwartz. Comm. Maxwell was absent.

1. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Maggi, to approve the minutes as submitted of ANC 2B's meeting on August 10, 1988. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.
2. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to approve the minutes as amended of ANC 2B's special meeting of September 6, 1988. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 abstention (Comm Rieffel).
3. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Maggi, to support ABC Application No. 7772 for a new Retailer's License Class C/R of J.O.C., Inc., t/a El Caminante, 2002 P St., N.W. Motion adopted, 4 yeas, 2 abstentions (Comms. Bass and Reiffel).
4. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Grandis, to oppose a Public Space Application for a flower stand at the northwest corner of Connecticut and R Streets, N.W. on the grounds that 1) there is insufficient space on the sidewalk at that corner for a flower stand, 2) city policy prohibits sidewalk stands north of Dupont Circle on the west side of Connecticut Avenue, and 3) the application would establish a precedent for sidewalk stands not being operated by the stand owner. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.
5. Motion by Comm. Schwager, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to adopt the points submitted by the Secretary, Comm. Bass, on the "Draft Ward 2 Plan," to urge their inclusion in pending legislation, and to urge Council Member Wilson to examine the plans for wards with areas abutting Ward 2 to insure consistency with the Ward 2 Plan. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.
6. Motion by Comm. Schwartz to take no position on HPA Application 88-918, Domino's Pizza, 1528 Connecticut Avenue, N.W. because of concerns about the use of the building. Motion failed for lack of a second.
7. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Schwartz, to oppose HPA Application 88-918, Domino's Pizza, 1528 Connecticut Avenue, N.W. because the design for a wall to shield the cooling plant from view detracts from the symmetry of the building and the materials used for the wall are not consistent with the rest of the building. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.

8. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Maggi, to recommend that Mayor Barry consider appointing retiring ANC 2B Commissioner Renee ~~Schwartz~~ to a vacancy on the D.C. Zoning Commission. Motion adopted, 5 yeas, 1 abstention (Comm. Schwager). *Schwager*

9. Motion by Comm. Schwager, seconded by Comm. Bass, to send a letter to the headquarters of the U.S. Park Service requesting that sufficient funds be reallocated in the Park Service budget to ensure that patrols in Dupont Circle are continued and expanded. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.

The Commission adjourned at 9:22 p.m.
