

MINUTES OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY ANC 2B, SEPTEMBER 28, 1988

Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B met at a public meeting at 7:30 p.m., September 28, 1988 at St. Thomas' Parrish, 1772 Church Street, N.W. Commissioners present were Bass, Grandis, Maggi, Rieffel, Schwager, and Schwartz. Comm. Maxwell was absent.

1. Motion by Comm. Schwartz, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to approve the minutes as submitted of ANC 2B's meeting on September 14, 1988. Motion adopted, 5 yeas (Comm. Grandis was absent for the vote).
2. Motion by Comm. Rieffel, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to approve the minutes as submitted of ANC 2B's special meeting of August 24, 1988. Motion adopted, 5 yeas (Comm. Grandis was absent for the vote).
3. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to appeal to the Board of Zoning Appeals the Zoning Administrator's action in issuing a certificate of occupancy on August 15, 1988 for an art gallery in an R-5-B zone at 1763 R Street, N.W., which approval was subsequent to the promulgation of regulations forbidding location of art galleries in a residential zone as a matter of right. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.
4. Motion by Comm. Grandis, seconded by Comm. Schwager, to adopt a Resolution to urge Dupont Circle residents to participate in the activities on October 8-10 commemorating the first anniversary of the display of the Names Project Quilt honoring persons who have died of or are living with AIDS. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.
5. Motion by Comm. Schwager, seconded by Comm. Rieffel, to support the Application to Occupy Public Space for the display and sale of flowers by Angie's New Leaf, 1521 17th Street, N.W., which is and shall be in conformance with the 17th Street Design Plan. Motion adopted, 6 yeas.
