MINUTES OF THE MEETING
OF THE
DUPONT CIRCLE ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION
HELD FEBRUARY 23, 1989

Follow up:

A regularly stated meeting of the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC 2B) was held on Wednesday, February 22, 1989 at 7:30 p.m. Present were all commissioners (Bass, Evans, Gaugler, Grandis, Maggi, Moses and Rieffel). Mr. Grandis announced that the ANC's Staff Coordinator, Vernon Palmer, is hospitalized at George Washington University Hospital, and encouraged persons who know him to write, but to avoid telephone calls and visits until Mr. Palmer is stronger.

Members of the community presented the following concerns:

-Three residents of the ANC voiced opposition to abortions in general, and the existence of the Planned Parenthood clinic at 17th and Q in particular. They were asked to forward a letter to the ANC chairman explaining the action they requested of the ANC.

-A "No Standing" sign is missing on 17th Street near P, leading to parking problems.

-Trucks servicing the Larimer's store are creating excessive noise.

Moses

The motion by Mr. Evans, seconded by Ms. Moses, to table the BZA Application 15009 of Aaron I. Fleischman and Charles S. Walsh on behalf of the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia for permission to operate a

chancery in an SP-1 District at premises at 1725 N Street, N.W., (Square 158, Lot 803) until the next meeting of the ANC, which will be held on March 8, 1989, was approved with all commissioners voting in favor except Mr. Maggi, who abstained.

The motion by Mr. Gaugler, seconded by Ms. Moses, to refer to the Committee on Streets, Alleys, and Public Spaces the concerns raised by Allen J. Roth, Ward 2 Representative to the Citizens' Advisory Task Force on Neighborhood Offstreet Parking, was approved with all commissioners voting in favor.

→ DG's committee

The motion by Mr. Grandis, seconded by Mrs. Rieffel, to adopt the budget for FY 1989 as presented by the treasurer, was approved with all commissioners voting in favor. A copy of the approved budget is appended as Attachment A.

The motion by Mr. Grandis, seconded by Ms. Moses, to adopt the minutes of the last meeting, with corrections as noted, was approved with all commissioners voting in favor except Mr. Maggi, who abstained.

The motion by Mr. Grandis, seconded by Mr. Maggi, to ask the appropriate governmental body to hold hearings, prior to the issuance of a certificate of occupancy or a building permit, to review the suitability of the sidewalk cafe structure proposed for 11 Dupont Circle was approved, with all commissioners voting in favor except Ms. Moses, who was absent.

The motion by Mrs. Rieffel, seconded by Mr. Grandis, that the ANC adopt the seven points drafted by Mr. Bass for use in following up on the liquor license moratorium hearing of the preceding week was approved with all commissioners voting in favor except Mrs. Moses, who was absent. A copy of the seven points is appended as Attachment B.

The motion by Mr. Maggi, seconded by Mr. Grandis, that the ANC respectfully request that the ABC Board suspend consideration of new liquor licenses in the moratorium area until the Board has issued a final order on the moratorium petition was approved, with all commissioners voting in favor, except Mrs. Moses, who was absent.

The motion by Mr. Grandis, seconded by Mr. Gaugler, that the ANC adopt the conditions proposed by Mr. Bass for incorporation into an agreement between the city and the Jewish Community Center in the event the city sells back to the Jewish Community Center the property at 16th and Q Streets was approved with all commissioners present voting in favor except Ms. Moses, who was absent. A copy of the conditions is appended as Attachment C.

The motion by Mr. Maggi, seconded by Mr. Grandis, that the Ross School grant request be denied due to a lack of funds was approved with all commissioners present voting in favor except Ms. Moses, who was absent.
