Dear Chair Marcou:

At its regular meeting on December 13, 2017, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 8 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (8-0-0):

WHEREAS, the applicant at 717 Madison Place NW and 1520 H Street NW proposes to occupy public space for the purpose of installing security bollards and streetscape work, including updates to curb and gutters, sidewalks, landscaping, and ADA improvements, and

WHEREAS, the applicant has requested that ANC 2B ask for a delay in the review of its application.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B requests a 30-day delay of the consideration of the public space application for 717 Madison Place NW and 1520 H Street NW in order to allow the Commission to further discuss the project plans with the applicant.
