Dear Chairman Anderson,

At its regular meeting on November 8, 2017, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 5 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (5-0-0):

ANC 2B protests Bangkok Thai Dining’s application for a substantial change to the establishment’s Retailer’s Class “C” Restaurant license based on adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood, until a settlement agreement has been successfully negotiated between the ANC and the applicant.

Due to his position on the ABC Board, Commissioner Silverstein did not participate in this discussion.
