At its regular meeting on June 14, 2017, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 7 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (4-3-0):

ANC 2B protests Safeway’s (ABRA-105295) application for a new new Retailer’s Class “B” Grocery Store license at 1701 Corcoran Street NW based on adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood, subject to a negotiation of a settlement agreement that allows for the peaceful cohabitation with current neighbors.
