Dear Chairwoman Miller:

At its regular meeting on November 13, 2013 the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 6 of 9 Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following motion by a vote of (5-0-1):

ANC 2B protests the renewal of the license for Dirty Martini on the basis of peace, order, and quiet (“POQ”), subject to the successful negotiation of a settlement agreement or other resolution of the ANC’s POQ concerns.

Due to his position on the ABC Board, Commissioner Silverstein did not participate in this matter.
