At its regular meeting on July 9, 2014, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 7 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (7-0):

ANC 2B protests the application for Cities — on the basis of peace, order, and quiet — until the applicant can provide additional details on hours of operation. The applicant did not appear to present the application at the ANC’s July 2014 public meeting. The ANC further requests that the applicant attend our August 2014 public meeting to discuss the application.
