RE: Resolution on DC Fire and Emergency Services Response on June 3, 2015

Dear Chief Dean,

At its regular meeting on June 10, 2015, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 9 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (9-0):

Whereas the District of Columbia Fire and Emergency Medical Services rapidly responded to a conflagration engulfing the home at 1600 Riggs Place, NW Washington, DC on June 3 at approximately 2:30AM.

Whereas the District of Columbia Fire and Emergency Medical Services valiant efforts to contain the blaze at 1600 Riggs Place, NW prevented the spread of the fire to other homes on the block.

Whereas injuries were sustained by several firefighters during their brave efforts to extinguish the blaze at 1600 Riggs Place, NW.

Therefore ANC 2B commends and salutes the District of Columbia Fire and Emergency Medical Services for their actions taken on June 3rd, 2015.

In addition, ANC 2B thanks inspectors from the Code Enforcement Branch for speaking with our community and providing education on how to prevent fires and serious injuries from fires.
