At its regular meeting on November 13, 2019, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 9 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (9-0-0):

ANC 2B protests Annabelle’s application for a substantial change to the establishment’s Retailer’s Class “C” Restaurant license at 2130 Florida Avenue NW (to increase total occupancy load) based on the adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood and based on the adverse impact on residential parking needs and vehicular and pedestrian safety, pending the negotiation of a settlement agreement between the applicant and the ANC.
