 - i. **Nature of Substantial Change:** Applicant requests to expand the capacity on the existing fourth and fifth floors and to add the third floor to its licensed premises. The capacity of the third floor will be 325. The capacity of the fourth floor will be 315. The capacity of the fifth floor will be 335. Total occupancy load of the entire premises will increase from 100 to 975.
