Dear Chairman Jordan,

At its regular meeting on September 9, 2015, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 6 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of 6-0:

Whereas the applicant at 1100 15th St NW requires a zoning variance to reduce the height of certain portions of its proposed penthouse to comply with current zoning regulations; and

Whereas ANC 2B commends the developer for applying for the variance which minimizes penthouse height in certain locations rather than a variance which maximizes height.

Be it RESOLVED ANC 2B supports the project as proposed.
