Dear Chairwoman Miller,

At its regular meeting on July 10, 2013 the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With all of the Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following motion by a vote of (8-0):

Whereas additional documentation and drawings are needed to verify that soundproofing materials are to be used in order to not impact the residences on 18th Street currently there and those to come;

Whereas the ANC has concerns relating to the establishment's noise potential, hours, occupancy load, and requested entertainment endorsement;

Therefore be it resolved that ANC 2B protests the application in order to preserve peace, order, and quiet, subject to the negotiation of a Settlement Agreement between the ANC and the applicant.

Due to his position on the ABC Board, Commissioner Silverstein did not participate in the vote.
