At its regular meeting on June 14, 2017, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 8 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (8-0-0):

ANC 2B supports Akridge’s public space application for streetscape improvements as part of their new development at 1101 16th Street NW based on the applicant’s plans to bring the new development into ADA-compliance, the non-conforming structure that the applicant’s new development will be replacing, and the applicant’s proposed addition of ample green space in front of the new development.
