Dear Chairwoman Heath:

At its regular meeting on June 14, 2017, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With 8 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (8-0-0):

WHEREAS, the project as proposed is within the Dupont Circle Historic District and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B,

WHEREAS, the project as proposed intends to construct an addition which will be visible from the street.

WHEREAS, while ANC 2B typically opposes additions visible from the street due to historic preservation concerns, the specific context of this block and alley on 18th Street NW includes several taller buildings, including a nine-story office building, and the project is across the street from an under-construction church and apartment building which will be nearly 70 feet tall, and

WHEREAS, the proposed addition, if designed with matching brick so that it blends in with the current and surrounding historic context, is understandable and supportable.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports the project as proposed.
