At its regular meeting on January 10, 2018, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With 8 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (7-0-1):

WHEREAS, the applicant at 717 Madison Place NW and 1520 H Street NW proposes to occupy public space for the purpose of installing security bollards, streetscape work, including updates to curb and gutters, sidewalks, landscaping, and ADA improvements,

WHEREAS, the project goal is to provide vehicle mitigation while enhancing the public space, and

WHEREAS, the project objectives are to:

- Respect the sensitivity of the historic site
- Enhance pedestrian mobility
- Preserve canopy tree character of H Street and Madison Place
- Maintain bike connections along Madison Place.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports the project as proposed as a necessary security measure.
