At its regular meeting on December 13, 2017, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With 6 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (6-0-0):

WHEREAS, the applicant at 888 16th Street NW proposes to occupy public space for the purpose of streetscape work, including reduction of an existing curb cut, new steps, updates to existing globe lights, and ADA improvements,

WHEREAS, ANC 2B believes that the current plans are an incredible improvement to the built environment along 16th Street NW, and

WHEREAS, ANC 2B wishes to commend the developer and architect for effectively incorporating greenery on their public space along 16th Street NW and hopes that more greenery will be proposed in developments in Dupont Circle.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports the public space application for 888 16th Street NW as proposed.
