Dear Chairman Anderson,

At its regular meeting on July 12, 2017, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 7 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (7-0-0):

ANC 2B protests Effigy’s application for a new Retailer’s Class “C” Nightclub license at 1720 I Street NW based on the effect of the establishment on real property values; the effect of the establishment on peace, order, and quiet, including the noise and litter provisions set forth in §§ 25-725 and 25-726; and the effect of the establishment upon residential parking needs and vehicular and pedestrian safety, subject to the negotiation of a settlement agreement that allows for the peaceful cohabitation with current neighbors.

Due to his position on the ABC Board, Commissioner Silverstein did not participate in this discussion.
