RE: Public Space Application by Wawa for a New, Un-Enclosed Sidewalk Cafe at 1111 19th Street NW (DDOT #10402116)

Dear Chair Marcou:

At its regular meeting on July 12, 2017, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 7 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (7-0-0):

ANC 2B supports Wawa’s public space application for a new, un-enclosed sidewalk cafe at 1111 19th Street NW. The Commission appreciates the applicant’s chosen design for the trash receptacles that will be installed in the proposed sidewalk cafe.

The Commission notes that the applicant’s proposed sidewalk cafe meets the ANC’s published Public Space Guidelines, which state that sidewalk cafes should allow for a minimum of ten feet of sidewalk clearance. The Commission further notes that the proposed sidewalk cafe will continue to meet these guidelines after a planned bioretention garden is installed along the adjacent curb on the east side of 19th Street NW.
