At its regular meeting on November 13, 2013 the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 6 of 9 Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following motion by a vote of (6-0):

Based on the understanding that other parties have filed or intend to file a protest for this application, ANC 2B protests the substantial change to the existing CR license for Bar Charley on the basis of peace, order, and quiet (“POQ”), subject to the successful negotiation of a settlement agreement or other resolution of the Commission’s POQ concerns related to this establishment.
