At its regular meeting on May 8, 2013 the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With all of the Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (9-0).

WHEREAS the Office of Planning (OP) has announced funds for neighborhood planning to develop a “vibrant streets” retail corridor;

WHEREAS the Golden Triangle BID has prepared an application for the area on and around Connecticut Avenue NW, south of Dupont Circle;
