Dear Chairman Marcou,

At its regular meeting on July 10, 2013 the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With all of the Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following motion by a vote of (9-0):

Whereas, ANC 2B supports the proposed curb cut for handicapped use subject to the reservation of parking spaces in order to provide for safe access;

Whereas, ANC 2B suggests the addition of a small grade or curb to distinguish the decorative pedestrian paving from the drive aisle on the south side of the building in order to discourage parking in that location;

Whereas, ANC 2B supports the stair concept on the north (P Street) side of the building;

Therefore, be it resolved that ANC 2B supports the public space permit application, recognizing that approval may result in the loss of one on-street parking space.
