Dear Chairperson Marcou,

At its regular meeting on December 10, 2014, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 6 of 8 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (5-0-1).

Whereas the applicant at 1900 N St requests a curb cut to accommodate parking for a new ten story building on N St between 19th and 20th; and

Whereas the construction of the building may have negative impacts on traffic safety, pedestrian safety, and neighbors’ quality of life during construction;

Be it resolved the ANC conditionally supports the curb cut request based on a successful completion of a memorandum of understanding regarding construction impacts between the developer, neighbors, and the ANC.
