At its regular meeting on July 8, 2015, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 7 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (7-0):

ANC 2B hereby protests the application for a new CR license for Brick Lane (ABRA-098427) on the basis of peace, order and quiet, subject to the successful negotiation of a settlement agreement that alleviates the concerns of neighbors.


Any ANC2B Commissioner may represent ANC2B on this matter before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.
