At its regular meeting on May 11, 2016, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood  
Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter.  
With 7 of 8 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the  
Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (6-0-0):

ANC 2B protests the application for the Doubletree Washington DC at 1515 Rhode  
Island Avenue NW (ABRA-079383) to renew the establishment’s Retailer’s Class “C”  
Hotel license based on adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood,  
subject to a renegotiation of the establishment’s settlement agreement that allows for the  
peaceful cohabitation with current neighbors.

Due to his position on the ABC Board, Commissioner Silverstein did not participate in  
this discussion.
