RE: Public Space Application by the Kossuth Foundation to Install a Temporary Statue at 2001 Massachusetts Avenue NW (DDOT #179846)

Dear Chair Marcou:

At its regular meeting on July 13, 2016, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 9 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (9-0-0):

WHEREAS, the Kossuth Foundation at 2001 Massachusetts Avenue NW proposes to install a temporary statue to commemorate the 60th anniversary of the Hungarian Revolution on its public parking, and

WHEREAS, the proposed statue is ephemeral for the month of October and is located on a grass area that is typically not publicly accessible.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports the public space application and urges the Public Space Committee to schedule a hearing in order to allow for sufficient time for the applicant to install the statue in October.
