At its regular meeting on May 10, 2017, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 5 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (5-0-0):

ANC 2B protests B&B’s application for a new Retailer’s Class “C” Restaurant license at 1351 Connecticut Avenue NW based on adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood, subject to the negotiation of a settlement agreement that allows for the peaceful cohabitation with current neighbors.

Due to his position on the ABC Board, Commissioner Silverstein did not participate in this discussion.
