

9. Provide and install a Community Bulletin Board for use by the community;
10. Maintain a policy of no window advertisements;
11. Provide a working water fountain in the store.

Safeway plans to utilize new space to increase the meat department by 40 feet, produce by 28 feet, and dairy by 28 feet. However, we reserve the right to determine the merchandising mix which, as food retailers, we believe best fits the needs of the community in the years ahead.

All of the above, of course, are subject to the approval of the BZA and any special requirements that body may impose on us.

Additionally, we will be contacting Ross Public School PTA next week with regard to its proposed nutrition project, to better determine to what extent we can support the proposed program. We would have entered into this relationship and will continue to do so irregardless of the zoning action. Safeway's Home Economist will make initial contact next week but a decision as to the extent of our support will only be made until we have completed a thorough examination of the proposal, its cost and current resources available.
