At its regular meeting on June 13, 2018, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 9 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (9-0-0):

ANC 2B has an understanding that Brick Lane Restaurant’s public space application to convert an un-enclosed sidewalk café to an enclosed sidewalk café at 1636 17th Street NW will be removed from the agenda for the Public Space Committee’s June 2018 meeting, however, if the application is not removed from the agenda then ANC 2B and the applicant jointly request a 30-day delay of the consideration of the application.
