Dear Chairman Anderson,

At its regular meeting on July 11, 2018, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 8 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (8-0-0):

ANC 2B protests the Heurich House Museum’s application for a substantial change to the establishment’s Retailer’s Class “CX” Multipurpose Facility license based on the adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood, pending the successful negotiation of a settlement agreement between the ANC and the applicant.

Due to his position on the ABC Board, Commissioner Silverstein did not participate in this discussion.
