At its regular meeting on January 9, 2019, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. WHEREAS, the Phillips Collection has served the Dupont Circle and District of Columbia communities for 98 years,

WHEREAS, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2B has worked with the Phillips Collection over the years, including through the Neighborhood Liaison Committee, which was formed in a voluntary agreement with neighbors as the museum expanded nearly 20 years ago, and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports the Phillips Collection's request for funding for its proposed centennial projects.
