RE: The District Department of Transportation's Proposed Rulemaking on Residential Parking Regulations

Dear Mr. Emerine:

At its special meeting on December 4, 2018, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With 6 of 8 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (5-1-0):

WHEREAS, ANC 2B appreciates the changes that were made since 2016 to the proposed rulemaking on residential parking regulations,

WHEREAS, ANC 2B believes that the regulations in the second proposed rulemaking are better than they were two years ago,

WHEREAS, ANC 2B appreciates the change in the second proposed rulemaking which resulted in the ability for an ANC to propose five or more blocks for residential parking instead of an all-or-nothing approach for an ANC,

WHEREAS, ANC 2B is currently working with the District Department of Transportation on the recommendations made in the ANC's Dupont / Kalorama Curbside Management Study resolution passed in July of 2018, and

WHEREAS, ANC 2B opposes the concept of residential-only parking street sides as parking policy within the District of Columbia.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B opposes the District Department of Transportation's proposed rulemaking on residential parking regulations.

Commissioners Randy Downs (<u>2B05@anc.dc.gov</u>) and Daniel Warwick (<u>2B02@anc.dc.gov</u>) are the Commission's representatives in this matter.
