At its regular meeting on March 13, 2019, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With 9 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (8-0-1):

WHEREAS, the Capital Pride Block Party is an annual celebration of the diversity of the Dupont Circle neighborhood and of the District, and

WHEREAS, the Capital Pride Block Party is partially staged within the borders of ANC 2B.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports the Capital Pride Alliance's special event application for the 2019 Capital Pride Block Party on Saturday, June 8th, 2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports the Capital Pride Alliance's request for a complete reimbursement for any applicable police or public space permit fees that would be charged for the event.
