Dear Chairman Anderson,

At its regular meeting on May 8, 2019, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With 8 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (8-0-0):

ANC 2B protests Lupo Verde's application to terminate the settlement agreement for the establishment's Retailer's Class "C" Restaurant license at 1401 T Street NW based on the adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood in order to renegotiate the settlement agreement with the establishment on the basis of consistency with proximate retailers with regards to outdoor heaters and patio music, as well as on the basis of the interim placement of trash receptacles outside when empty or during the cleaning of the kitchen.

Due to his position on the ABC Board, Commissioner Silverstein did not participate in this discussion.
