At its regular meeting on June 12, 2019, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 8 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (8-0-0):

ANC 2B protests Rebellion’s application for renewal of the establishment’s Retailer’s Class “C” Restaurant license at 1836 18th Street NW based on the adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood, pending the negotiation of a settlement agreement between the applicant and the ANC.
