At its regular meeting on November 13, 2019, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 9 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (9-0-0):

WHEREAS, the Golden Triangle Business Improvement District (BID) seeks to install two temporary artworks in 2019, one at the intersection of K Street and Connecticut Avenue NW and one at the intersection of Dupont Circle and Connecticut Avenue NW (the Connecticut Avenue Overlook).

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports the Golden Triangle BID’s public space application to install temporary artworks at these two intersections.
