RE: Needed Improvements to the S Street NW Dog Park

Dear Director Hunter:

At its regular meeting on October 10, 2019, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With 7 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (7-0-0):

WHEREAS, the S Street NW Dog Park opened more than ten years ago and is extremely popular and heavily used,

WHEREAS, the K-9 turf originally installed has a seven year guarantee and has degraded over time, and

WHEREAS, there are dozens of holes in the turf and it is beginning to completely degrade in places.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B urges the Department of Parks and Recreation to repair or replace the degraded K-9 turf as quickly as possible to protect the drainage system underneath and ensure safe use of the park for both people and dogs.
