RE: 2021 Capital Pride Activities in ANC 2B

Dear Ms. Mitchell and Director Hunter,

At its special meeting on June 16, 2021, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With 8 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (8-0-0):

WHEREAS, ANC 2B partnered in the highly successful Pride Walk of June 12th, 2021, in which thousands of people participated, including the Vice President of the United States and the Second Gentleman, an event that drew worldwide news coverage, and

WHEREAS, given the extraordinary success of that event, partnering groups now wish to hold a neighborhood event during the final week of Pride Month and have asked ANC 2B to partner in planning and holding such an event.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports a partnership with the Capital Pride Alliance, Historic Dupont Circle Main Streets, the Dupont Circle BID, and other groups to hold pride activities within the boundaries of ANC 2B.
