Re: Request for a substantial change to liquor license for Masa 14 (1825 14th Street, NW)

Dear Chairman Brodsky:

At its regular meeting on February 17, 2010, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With seven of nine Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following motion by a vote of (7-0).

ANC 2B intended to take up the matter of a substantial change application by Masa 14 (1825 14th Street, NW) at its regularly scheduled meeting. Because of a state of emergency created by the blizzard, the ANC could not meet until the following Wednesday. During that time the protest period ended but five Commissioners signed a timely protest. Now the Commissioners have asked that the ANC represent their interests and at the February 17 meeting, the ANC agreed unanimously to represent the interests of those five protesting Commissioners.
