RE: 1250 Connecticut Avenue NW – “City Tap 1250 DC LLC” – ABRA-106537 – Application for a Substantial Change to the Establishment’s Retailer’s Class “C” Restaurant License

Dear Chair Anderson,

At its regular meeting on May 10, 2023, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With 9 of 9 Commissioners in attendance, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (9-0-0):

WHEREAS, City Tap House, located at 1250 Connecticut Avenue NW in single member district 2B05 of ANC 2B, holds a Retailer’s Class “C” Restaurant license,

WHEREAS, the applicant has operated at this location since 2017 without notable incident,

WHEREAS, City Tap House has applied for an entertainment endorsement to offer live entertainment inside of the establishment between 11:00 am and 2:00 am on Sundays through Saturdays,

WHEREAS, it is believed that such indoor entertainment should not adversely affect the neighborhood, as the nearest residences are more than a block away, and

WHEREAS, many other establishments within two blocks of City Tap House are permitted to offer entertainment.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2B supports City Tap House’s application for an indoor entertainment endorsement for its license.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC 2B requests, if the endorsement is approved, that the establishment’s settlement agreement be revised to include the allowed hours for indoor entertainment.
